



**COLORADO RIVER INDIAN TRIBES POLICE DEPARTMENT
STATEMENT ON RESPONSE TO INCIDENT AT BLAKE PRIMARY SCHOOL**

On February 20th, 2018 at approximately 15:00 hours, the Colorado River Indian Tribes (CRIT) School Resource Officer G. Varela responded to a call from Parker Police Department School Resource Officer J. Martinez about an incident at Blake Primary School. Officer Varela was advised a student threatened to bring a gun to school and shoot two other students at Blake Primary School. At approximately 15:25 hours Officer Varela made contact with the residence of the parent and no firearm was located after a search of the property. The investigation continued the following morning with the parents and students who were the subject of the threat. It has been determined that no firearms are accessible to the student and the student did not intend to or have the means to carry out the threat. CRIT Officers intend to continue regular patrols of the schools.
