Applications are processed through our office for any Native American for grades 8-12. Deadline is two (2) months prior to school beginning: July for 1st semester or November for 2nd semester.

Must also submit:

1. Physical Exam
2. Immunization Records
3. Official Transcripts from last school
4. Copy of Social Security Card
5. Copy of Birth Certificate
6. Social Summary (contact our office for an appointment)
7. Copy of Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB)
8. Copies of Legal/Custody hearings, if any
9. Must meet Requirements from the school attending

CLOTHING ALLOWANCE

1. CRIT Tribal Member
2. Copy of acceptance letter required along with application for assistance
3. Allowance per semester based on availability of funds

HIGHER EDUCATION

ELIGIBILITY

1. CRTT Tribal Member
2. 2.50 Cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) High School or 45 GED score, Former/Continuing students are required to submit an Official Transcript from last institution funded.
3. Apply by June 30th Fall/Winter/Spring or October 30th Winter/Spring only
4. Be admitted to a Community College or University

INCENTIVE PROGRAM

1. Current student funded under Higher Education Program
2. Honor Roll, Dean's List, President's List for Fall/Winter or Spring
3. Award based on availability of funds
4. Submit copy of certificate prior to the end of the following semester/quarter for which honor was received

VOCATIONAL TRAINING

ELIGIBILITY

1. CRTT Tribal Member
2. 2.50 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) High School or 45 GED score
3. Apply by June 30th Fall/Winter/Spring or October 30th Winter/Spring only
4. Be admitted to a Vocational Training Institute

INCENTIVE PROGRAM

1. Current Student funded under Vocational Training Program
2. Honor Roll or Perfect Attendance
3. Award based on availability of funds
4. Submit copy of certificate prior to the end of the following module, phase, etc., for which honor was received

COMPUTER ASSISTANCE

1. Current student funded under the Higher Education Program
2. Sophomore status with a 2.50 cumulative Grade Point Average (GPA) or a Junior/Senior status in Good Standing, Academic Probation students not eligible.
3. Allowance based on availability of funds
4. Complete paperwork before end of current semester

GRADUATION ASSISTANCE

1. Current students funded under the Higher Education Program
2. Graduation confirmed by school
3. Allowance cap/gown for announcements, etc., based on availability of funds
